Trinity to fund improvements at TransCanada Highway and Sarcee Trail interchange

Trinity Development Group is working with the City of Calgary to fund and construct improvements to the interchange at Sarcee Trail and TransCanada Highway.

A key goal of the project is to improve traffic flow in the area, and ensure that the Trinity Hills project does not impact traffic volumes and commute times for those living in surrounding areas. The changes will also provide access to the Trinity Hills development.

These interchange improvements will also eliminate conflict points, increasing safety for all drivers.

Construction of the interchange is projected to begin in February 2016 and currently scheduled to be operationally complete by December 2016. Information sessions on the interchange project will be held in January 2016.

Next Steps: Working towards a 2016 Construction start

Following City Council approval in July 2015 of the Trinity Hills project, Trinity Development group has been actively proceeding with plans for this dynamic mixed-use neighbourhood. Trinity is creating a new Calgary community that will include residential, office, entertainment and retail amenities for residents and visitors to enjoy.

Current work on this project includes:

- Engineers are completing the design and awarding the contract for the new Trinity funded Sarcee Trail interchange;
- Engineers are completing the tentative subdivision plan which will separate out the + 160 acre natural parkland that Trinity committed to providing the City for a new regional park;
- Trinity is working with its architects to prepare a detailed concept plan and initial development permit plans.

With all of this planning underway, Trinity is working towards a construction start on the lands in 2016.
